Dear SMBSC Shareholder,

In 2023, SMBSC conducted four Official Variety Trials within the Cooperative growing area. These trials were located near Renville, Hector, Lake Lillian, and Murdock. All four sites were harvested, and the data was combined and used in the variety seed approval process for the 2024 crop. In addition to the yield data from these sites, varieties were also evaluated for Aphanomyces root rot, Cercospora leaf spot, and Rhizoctonia root rot at various disease nurseries. The 2023 data was combined with the 2022 and 2021 Official Trial data and is summarized in the data sheets found on the website below.

For the 2024 crop, SMBSC has granted Full Approval Status to seven varieties and Test Market Status to five varieties, the latter of which allows planting on up to 10% of the Cooperative acreage. This Test Market Status aims to introduce shareholders to new varieties that have the potential to achieve Full or Specialty Approval in one to two years. Additionally, one variety has been approved as an Aphanomyces Specialty Variety, five as Rhizoctonia Specialty Varieties, and one as a Cercospora Specialty Variety. However, no varieties have been approved as High Sugar Specialty Varieties for the upcoming crop.
